Dr. Timothy Hagen is on the faculty of UW-Madison School of Music, where he teaches flute and performs with the Wingra Wind Quintet. His flute playing has been praised for his “technical virtuosity and musical sensitivity” (NewMusicBox) and “real flair” (The Well-Tempered Ear). He is a laureate of multiple national and international competitions, including the National Flute Association’s Myrna Brown Artist Competition and the Australian International Flute competition. He is principal flute of the Dubuque Symphony, has served as principal flute of the Missouri Symphony, and has performed with orchestras across the country, including the Minnesota Orchestra, San Antonio Symphony, and Dallas Wind Symphony. His compositions are performed by musicians throughout North America, and his scholarly works have appeared in journals of the National Flute Association and the British Flute Society. Dr. Hagen studied at The University of Texas at Austin, Colburn School, University of Southern California, and University of North Carolina School of the Arts, and his teachers include Marianne Gedigian, Jim Walker, Renée Siebert, Tadeu Coelho, Philip Dunigan, Felicia MacNaught, and Tina Ballard.
